<b>Absent</b>	Kay Lane (KL),
<b>1. Declaration of interest</b>	ACa declared an interest as he is a BT employee
<b>2. Telephone box removal</b>	Suffolk Coastal has asked the Parish Council to consider the option of closing the public phone service located nr <i>Marralomena</i> the Street. It was noted that following BT guidance, Boyton was entitled to a public call box and that despite its limited use (2 calls last year), it was deemed to be a valuable asset to the village specially if phone lines were “down” through electricity.cuts. The Council agreed to “object” to the proposal (3 to 2 in favour of objection)
<b>3. Purchase of kiosk</b>	The option to purchase the kiosk if the previous decision was over-ruled by Suffolk Coastal district council was discussed. Issues such as asset ownership, insurance, maintenance and upkeep were considered. In addition there was a concern that BT might charge for electricity in the future. The Council voted against the purchase of the Kiosk.
