Removal of BT Payphone | <p>The district Council is to consider BT's programme of proposed public payphone removals, one of which is in Boyton.</p> <p>It was agreed that Council should object to the proposal for the following reasons:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Poor mobile phone signal 2. The nearest payphone was over 1 mile away and that was on the proposed closure list. 3. Newly installed fibre broadband systems in some house had removed the copper wire. Thus power cuts would mean no access. 4. There is neither a shop or pub in the village 5. The village has seen an increase in walkers accessing local area. A payphone would assist in an emergency <p>It was agreed that a decision to adopt a kiosk would not be considered at this time.</p> |
